Case:

- Jean has MS and has no standing strength and Erik, her husband, cares for her fulltime.
- When we met them, he was physically lifting her between bed and chair, multiple times a day.
- Current equipment options didn't work for them
 - Jean was unsafe on a standing hoist
 - Mobile hoist too slow and didn't fit their house

Solution:

- Erik can manage transfers on his own without help and when caregiver help arrives he can go out on a bike ride
- The low force transfer is saving Erik's health
- The Kera is small and manoeuvrable fitting in their home especially using the short handle Kera sit2sit model
- The Kera sit2sit was funded by Enable
